Dear friend,

If you are reading these lines is very likely that you have just arrived in our community and that you are eager to get information about what your rights and duties are in your new place of residence. That is the main objective of this guide, to give you information about everything you have to know as a newcomer to make your integration in our society easier for you and about what resources are at your disposal to help you in this process.

First of all, welcome and congratulations, because I can imagine that taking the decision to emigrate to another country was not an easy one and on the other hand, arriving in Spain means to fulfil a dream for you.

I hope I can contribute to you and your family to get properly settled in our country and that your process of adaptation to our culture to be easy.

The Balearic Islands have traditionally been a host place which have offered opportunities for all newcomers. Currently, the government of this community is making an effort to guarantee all the rights of the immigrant population, whom specific helping measures are aimed to. Specifically, last October the city's department I manage was created to deal with the immigrants' problems in a differentiated way. There are information points where you will be explained how to access the social services, health care, education... It is important that you are not afraid, whatever your legal situation is, and that you call at the official institutions, that will help you to settle.

Every year more and more immigrant women arrive in our country, both as part of a family unit as well as by themselves, prepared to keep going their families who are left behind in their countries of origin. It is fundamental to remember that our society proposes certain values also applicable to the newcomer women. In particular, the equality treatment between men and women, whatever their place of origin is. For this reason, within the Integral Attention Scheme for Immigrant People started up by the Balearic Islands Government, special stress is made in getting immigrant women to work in legal conditions, so they can combine work and family life and they enjoy the same opportunities than Spanish men and women.

This "Welcome Guide fo Immigrant Women" wants to let you know about the rights you have as a woman and as an immigrant in your new society. We know that starting a new life is not easy, but we want to put all the means at your disposal –mediators, social benefits, legal advice, etc.– so your incorporation into our society is easier for you and your family.

Our Autonomous Region: organs of government, economy, and languages

The Balearic Islands consist of five islands, from larger to smaller: Mallorca, Menorca, Eivissa, Formentera, and Cabrera. Within the Spanish state, the islands enjoy a Statute of Autonomy since 1st March 1983, date which is commemorated every year as the Day of the Balearic Islands.

The autonomous institutional organization is integrated by the Parlament, the Balearic Islands

Government and the Presidency of the Autonomous Region. The government has administrative and executive functions; besides, it develops the regulations and budgets for the Autonomous Region. It is represented through the positions of Presidency, Vicepresidency, and thirteen Autonomous Region Councillors.

The government and administration of each of the islands that form the archipelago correspond to the Insular Councils. Finally, each municipality has its own Town Council.

The Balearic economy is based upon the service -mainly aimed to the touristic industry- and construction sectors, with a very marked seasonal side (from April to September).

You also need to take into consideration that two official languages co-exist on the islands -Catalan and Castilian- and that if you know both it will help you as much in your professional as in your personal aspects.

On the following pages you will find information about the main features of everyday life that you have to solve to get effectively incorporated into our community.



Residing in the community: rights and duties of foreign people

Foreign people from any of the 25 countries members of the European Union or people from other non-communitary countries who have a residence permit are recognised with the same rights and duties that Spaniards have by the current Spanish law*

The countries that belong to Europe-25 are: Germany, Belgium, Czech Republic, Cyprus, Denmark, Slovaquia, Slovenia, Spain, Stonia, Finland, France, Greece, Hungary, Ireland, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Netherlands, Polland, Portugal, United Kingdom, and Sweden.

If you come from a country which does not belong to the above mentioned and you do not have a residence authorization, your rights are reduced to: access to basic education, justice, basic social services, and health care. That is why it is important to fulfil the required conditions to obtain the residence and work permits.

In the following addresses you will obtain free information on all the issues that affect you as a foreigner. Due to the complexity of the legislation and its application, it is advisable that you consult about your particular situation with a legal service specialized in foreign affairs.

It is fundamental that you know in detail your rights and duties so you can feel an active citizen and integrated in your new municipality of residence.

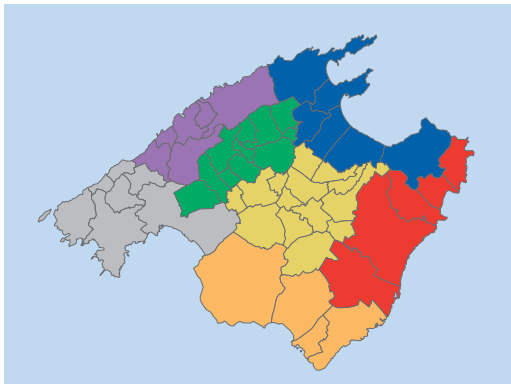
With this aim, the Women's Balearic Institute (Institut Balear de la Dona):

Town Councils

The city registration (Padrón) is a registration that identifies you as a citizen of your Town Council. It is compulsory both for Spanish and foreign people (with or without a legal situation in the country) and it is vital to obtain your health card, apply for a school place, to process your residence permit... In general, you are required to produce an identification card and the contract of the place where you are residing, rented or bought accommodation.

The Town Councils also offer, through their social service departments, a network of assistance for those people who are in an emergency or difficult situation. From them, you can get advice on how to get psycho-social support, access the temporary accommodation resources, you can cover your basic hygienic and food needs, and other provisions. Most centres also have intercultural mediators who can help you in case of trouble with languages or culture in the processing of these services and resources already mentioned. Centres for Infant and Adult Education

Schooling for boys and girls from 6 to 16 years is compulsory and free, no matter if they have a Spanish or foreign nationality. If you have a son or a daughter between 3 and 5, it is convenient that you register him/her in an infant education centre, or you can also apply for a free school place in the public and state assisted centres. Get information from the Schooling Office (Oficina de Escolarización). Furthermore, the Presidency and Sports Region Councillor (Conselleria de Presidència i Esports), in collaboration with the Women's Balearic Islands Institute (Institut Balear de la Dona), offers subventions for nurseries for children between 0 and 3 under certain conditions: ask at your Town Council or call 971 177400.

And talking about adults, you can access two types of training:

- Regulated: with an official recognition.
- Non-regulated: courses on languages, trade, etc without an official diploma and usually short courses.

In both cases, they can be totally or partially funded by some public administration.

The Balearic Islands Government, the Town Councils and several NGOs (Non-Governmental Organizations) organize free courses where you can learn Castilian and Catalan. The fluency in those languages will considerably help you for a better integration into our community. Get information about all the educative offer at your Town Council.

Finally, if you have a university degree and you want it to be recognised in Spain, you need to start its convalidation in the High Educational Inspection Area of the Education, Culture and

Sport Ministry (Área de Alta Inspección Educativa del Ministerio de Educación, Cultura y Deporte), Tl. 971 989412, and in your consulate. If you wish to continue your university studies, you can apply for a partial convalidation at the Balearic Islands University (UIB): get information about the requirements from the secretary's office of the corresponding School.

Local Surgeries

Health care of the public network is free for girls and boys under 18, for pregnant women, and adult people with a health card.

To apply for a health card, go to your nearest local surgery in your district or municipality where you have registered, with your identity card, your Town Council register certificate (certificado de empadronamiento), your residence or work permit and your Social Security card. If you do not have your Social Security card or your residence permit, seek advice from the main office of the Health Service from the Balearic Islands (Servei de Salut de les Illes Balears, IB-Salut).

Once you obtain your health card, you will be allocated a local surgery and a General Practitioner; besides, you will be able to be derived to see a specialist or be hospitalized in case you needed to, and you will enjoy a discount on the cost of medicines. You can make an appointment with your local surgery on the Tl. 902 079079.

The emergency telephone number to call an ambulance or ask for hospital assistance is 061.

Work and Training Occupational Courses

If you have nationality of a country which is not a member of the Europe-25, you need to obtain a permit that allows you to work in Spain, through the Foreign Local Office of the Spanish Government. It is also important that you register with the Social Security, this way you will enjoy the access to the public health network and get economic help or benefits if you face certain situations: sickness, birth of your child, unemployment, etc. If you are a wage-earner, the application to the Social Security will be made by the company hiring you; in case you are self-employed, you will have to deal with it.

To get more detailed information about the correct procedure and know all the resources to find a job, as well as the existing occupational training courses (Formación Ocupacional), you can go to the guidance services of the Occupation Service of the Balearic Islands (Servei d'Ocupació de les Illes Balears- SOIB) public network. In the following list you can see the work guidance points of its network, as well as its job centres. If you have the chance, visit their web page <http://soib.caib.es>: is a good source of information.

Another resource to be pointed out is the workers' trade unions: most of them offer legal advice and guidance in work and training.

Housing Services

The Balearic Institute of Housing (Institut Balear de la Vivienda - IBAVI) has, among other objectives, the promotion of housing under public protection, like council flats. This type of accommodation is awarded on a previous application, both for

renting or buying. To make your way easy, the Balearic Islands Government has started up a line of benefits with the Young Housing Autonomous Scheme (Plan Autonómico de Vivienda Joven) for people under 35, so they can rent or buy a place.

You can also ask for information in "Inhabited Palma" (Palma Habitada). This is a programme that mediates in the renting of accommodation, negotiating with the owners to get lower costs than the usual. To be able to access this service you must hand in a Council register certificate with a period of at least one year, work permit and a work contract, and a documentary evidence that proves that your incomes are over 35% of the rental of the flat you are applying for.

You can also, through the many private state agencies and newspapers, get a general idea of the features of your residence area and decide if you want accommodation just for you and your family, if you prefer to share a flat or rent a room. Remember that your Town Council can help you in case you need emergency temporary accommodation.

Social, Cultural, and Leisure Centres

In most municipalities you will find a noticeable public offer of cultural, sport, and recreational activities. Do not doubt in inscribing in some of them; you will enjoy your leisure time, you will get to know better the local social usages and you will make new friends. In general, the only documentation required to participate in these activities is your ID and may be some passport-sized photographs.

In the public libraries network you can apply for free book loans, and have a look at magazines and newspapers inside the building. Some of them also have music and video loans. For instance, the Library in the Women's Balearic Institute (Institut Balear de la Dona) is of public use and is specialized in women studies (Aragón, 26, 1st floor, Palma. Tls. 971 775116 and 971 775250, Monday to Friday from 09:00h. to 15:00h., and Tuesdays and Thursdays from 16:00h. to 18:00h.). Its bibliographic batch consists of books, videos, DVDs and periodical publications that you can look up on the Institute web (<http://ibdona.caib.es>).

The culture centres, youth centres and social and culture centres of the districts and municipalities also organize activities for training and entertainment in many different topics, both recreational and cultural. Specifically, the Casal de les Dones of the Women's Balearic Institute has several halls where they organize periodical seminars, courses, and gatherings for women, completely free.

If you are under 30, you can also go to a centre of the network called INFOJOVE: you will find there plenty of information about all sort of issues: studies, art, health, tourism, European programmes,

Finally, you will have the opportunity to practise your favourite sports in the sports facilities of your municipality, at different hours and with monthly fees quite lower than private centres. You will be told at the Culture and Sports Area of your Town Council how to locate the resources you are interested in.

Associations of Immigrants

Specially at the beginning of your arrival, when everything seems strange, it can be a good idea if you join an association: there you will find people from your own country who have gone through an experience similar to yours, people you will be able to share doubts with. They can

help you to understand the cultural, legal, work particularities of our country and community, and they will support you in the defense of your new rights and duties as a citizen.

In addition, these associations usually organize activities to support training and the seek of employment, and they organize parties and cultural days out that will encourage you and will stimulate you to feel an active part in our society.

As the number of associations is very big, the best thing to do is to get information from the Service of Legal Corporations of the Presidency and Sports Autonomous Region Council of the Balearic Islands Government (Servicio de Entidades Jurídicas de la Conselleria de Presidència i Esports del Govern de les Illes Balears), Tl. 971 177400 (entitatsjuridiques@caib.es), where you will be indicated what associations are inscribed in their registration. 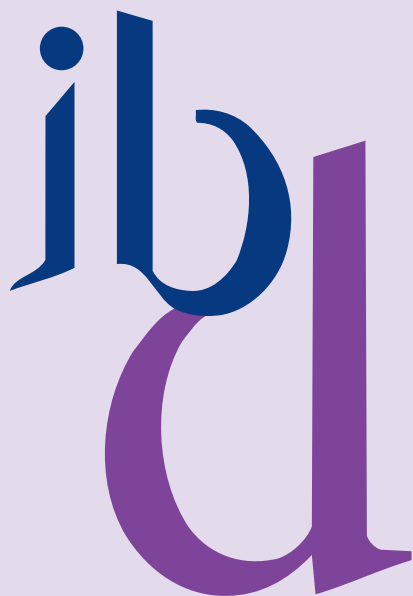
